We undertake for one year to follow the following resolutions:

1. every day to recite, for the intention of the sanctification of youth, psalm 42 « *Judica me* » or some other prayer;
2. to visit a church or oratory once a week in order to adore Our Lord truly present in the tabernacle;
3. once a year or more frequently: to attend Holy Mass celebrated according to the Roman Missal of 1962; to go to confession; to take part in an activity (Holy Hour, doctrinal conference, pro-life activity, charitable works, outing, etc.) on behalf of Juventutem; to donate to support the international bureau of Juventutem.

We acknowledge that:

1. Of themselves, the above commitments do not bind under sin.
2. Membership and the commitments that in involves are automatically renewed each year on the

feast of Our Lady Help of Christians (24 May), unless a contrary choice is explicitly notified.

3. As a lay Catholic organization, Juventutem does not depend on any particular clerical community or on any political movement.

We adhere to the contract of Juventutem: As we apply to found a Juventutem chapter, we acknowledge that:

1. the use of the name *Juventutem* and its emblem (a stylized monstrance) is not the property of any local group but that of the Fœderatio Internationalis Juventutem.
2. the use of the name *Juventutem* and its emblem is granted us by the Bureau of the Fœderatio Internationalis Juventutem by virtue of our membership in the Federation and only as long as the Bureau acknowledges our membership.

Our commitments are to speak and act according to the goals of Juventutem as defined in the Charter. This includes:

- paying the yearly financial contribution (amount to be approved) to the Bureau of the Federation – at least three members per chapter must pay the dues.
- communicating with the Bureau at least every semester, providing a written report regarding the activities that we have organized, the clerics that have assisted us, and any questions we may have.
- We acknowledge that the Bureau has authority to intervene in the way a group is managed, and to remove or appoint new members or new leaders if the need arises for the common good of the group.

Ultimately, should the Bureau assess that a group has failed to meet the goal of Juventutem: for being inactive for 6 months, for not communicating with the Federation, for not paying its dues, or for acting or writing in a manner which harms the common good of the Juventutem Federation, the Bureau has full authority to suppress the group. Once suppressed by the Bureau, a group is forbidden to continue and use the name and emblem of Juventutem; as well as the money collected on behalf of Juventutem; the social media set up on behalf of Juventutem; any assets obtained by virtue of the membership in the Fœderatio Internationalis Juventutem. Those must be transferred to the Bureau (finances and media) or dealt with according to its approval.

We shall soon receive by email the Certificate of Foundation-Affiliation of our group duly approved by the central office of the Fœderatio Internationalis Juventutem.
